During the first week of the month, students left quarters and soap at the laundromat and change on vending machines. They surprised customers at Sweet Grass with free coffee and pop for firemen. Kids also left Hershey Kisses in random houses and Bonus Bucks in Springs Food Store and True Value.

The second week of December FCCLA students left coloring books and crayons at the clinic and gifted doughnuts for law enforcement. They also covered the cost of a pizza buffet for an unsuspecting Springs Inn customer.

The RACK'D program also prompted kids to leave cards and ornaments at the nursing home and purchase popcorn
