Governor issues Executive Proclamation

On the heels of an Executive Proclamation issue by Governor Dennis Daugaard, the 74-member Wessington Springs Chapter of Family, Career and Community Leaders of America (FCCLA) is set to celebrate FCCLA Week February 12-16.

FCCLA offers students the chance to learn and develop leadership skills, with recent awards taken home by local students including: 2017 and 2018 Junior Knowledge Bowl Region Winner, 2017 Junior Knowledge Bowl State Winner, 2017 National Career Connection Project Winner.

The Junior High Chapter has completed recent projects such as: RACKD (Random Acts of Christmas Kindness) Project, Helping Hands Project (provide help to elementary teachers and businesses), Soup Lunch for teachers during American Education Week, Presentations on farm safety, hunting safety, PTSD, allergies, concussions, effect of texting and driving.

Students Taking Action for Recognition (STAR) Event Projects – (advocating awareness for farm safety, working with children, investigating careers, promoting FCCLA, recycling products, providing community service).

Senior Chapter projects include: Adopt a Family Project, Angel Tree Project, Elementary Fall Festival, STAR Event Projects (working with children, creating awareness of teen issues, investigating careers, demonstrating job interview skills, demonstrating parliamentary procedure, promoting FCCLA, illustrating the process for comparison shopping, helping people in need).




