TO ENSURE THAT EVERY CHILD ENROLLED IN THE WESSINGTON SPRINGS SCHOOL DISTRICT HAS THE NUTRITION THEY NEED BY PROVIDING NUTRITIOUS, EASY-TO-PREPARE MEALS FOR CHILDREN WHO DO NOT HAVE CONSISTENT ACCESS TO FOOD OVER THE WEEKEND.

THE PROGRAM IS CURRENTLY SENDING HOME APPROXIMATELY 30 BAGS EVERY WEEKEND. EACH BAG CONTAINS FOOD ITEMS FOR 2 BREAKFASTS, 4 ENTREES, AND A FEW SNACKS FOR EACH WEEKEND. \$150 PROVIDES ONE CHILD'S FOOD FOR ONE SEMESTER.
